



USA Pro Challenge Event Impacts and Road Closure

On Monday, August 18th from approximately 1:00pm to 5:00pm

No vehicular traffic will be able to enter Aspen or Snowmass via Hwy 82 Eastbound/up valley or Exit via Hwy 82 Westbound/down valley.

Independence Pass will remain open.

RFTA will continue to run as race allows into and out of Aspen
Motorists are encouraged to travel prior to 1pm and after 5pm

On Tuesday, August 19th from 10:30am until noon

Expect traffic delays on Hwy 82 up to 30 minutes

If you have an emergency call 911 or present yourself to the nearest uniformed emergency personnel

- **Friday August 15th 5pm through Tuesday, August 19th there will be street closures and re-routes in downtown Aspen. Log onto www.aspensnowmassupc.com for full details.**
- **Monday, August 18th 1:00pm to 5:00pm**
 - **From approximately 1:00pm to 5:00pm** no vehicular traffic will be able to enter/exit Aspen via HWY 82 (from the west/down valley) or Power Plant Road with exception of emergency vehicles and RFTA. From approximately 1pm-5pm, no vehicular traffic will be able to enter/exit Snowmass Village via Brush Creek Road and Owl Creek Road with exception of emergency vehicles.
 - **Entire Race Route closed 1:00pm- 5:00pm** Hwy 82 from Aspen to Owl Creek Road, Owl Creek Road, Brush Creek Road, Medicine Bow, Upper Ranch Road, Juniper Hill Rd, Smith Hill, W/J, McLain Flats, Cemetery Lane, Power Plant Road, Smuggler St. (from Power Plant Road to 1st St.) 1 St. (from Smuggler St. to Bleeker St.), Bleeker St. (from 1st to Mill st.), Mill St. (from Bleeker St. to Main St.) and Main St. (from Spring St. until Castle Creek Bridge).
 - **Festival Area**, Garmisch St. from Main St. to Hopkins Ave. Aspen St. from Main St. to Hyman Ave. Hopkins Ave. From Monarch St. to Garmisch St.
 - **Motorists are encouraged to travel prior to 1:00pm to 5:00pm.**
- **Tuesday August 19th**
 - There will be a “rolling” closure as the race exits Aspen, heads west on Main St, down Cemetery Lane, down McLain Flats, down W/J, up Smith Hill Way and West on HWY 82 to Two Rivers Road in Basalt. Two Rivers Road to Hwy 82 westbound. Hwy 82 westbound to Catherine Store Road, Main Street Carbondale, 7th Street, Euclid Ave, Weant Blvd and Hwy 133 over McClure Pass. Expect up to 30 minute delays if you are travelling on Hwy 82 between Aspen and Catherine Store Road.

ROUTE Monday August 18th 1:00pm to 5:00pm Aspen and Snowmass Village

Monday August 18th Aspen & Snowmass overall start circuit race. The cyclists travel in a “peloton” a group of cyclists and vehicles. Up to 125 racers and 120 vehicles will make up the peloton for this race. The vehicles include motorcycles, emergency assistance, media, and team vehicles for the racers. The course impacts will begin at approximately 1:00pm and last until 5:00pm.

Aspen: During the race approximately (1:00pm-5:00pm) there will be no vehicular traffic into or out of Aspen (via Hwy 82, or Power Plant Rd) with the exception of RFTA and emergency vehicles. Eastbound Hwy 82 will be turned around at Owl Creek Rd.

Snowmass Village: During the race approximately (1:00pm-5:00pm) there will be no vehicular traffic into or out of, Snowmass Village (via Brush Creek Rd or Owl Creek Rd) with the exception of emergency vehicles.

ROUTE Tuesday August 19th 10:30am Aspen to McClure Pass

Tuesday August 19th. Aspen Stage 2 start. During the race the course will not be accessible to vehicles and the race will maintain a “rolling closure” . Expect up to 30 minute delays if you are travelling on Hwy 82 between Aspen and Catherine Store Road. There will be a “rolling” closure as the race exits Aspen, heads West on Main St, down Cemetery Lane, down McLain Flats, down W/J, up Smith Hill Way and West on HWY 82 to Two Rivers Road in Basalt. Two Rivers Road to Hwy 82 Westbound. Hwy 82 westbound to Catherine Store Road, Main Street Carbondale, 7th Street, Euclid Ave, Weant Blvd and Hwy 133 over McClure Pass. Travel on Hwy 82 between Aspen and Catherine Store Road

- Basalt: 11:30am
- Carbondale: 12:00pm
- Expect significantly increased travel times south bound on Hwy 133 from Carbondale to Paonia starting at 12:00pm
- McClure Pass will be closed to vehicular traffic from 1pm to 3pm in both directions
