



## Town of Snowmass Village Public Works Road Division Permitting Requirements

The Town of Snowmass Village Public Works, Road Division requires all and any work, excavation, Obstructions, New or Reestablished Access to town roads to obtain an approved permit with fees paid and security deposits in place through the Public Works Department prior to the start of any work.

### R.O.W. (Right-of-Way) Excavation Permits Requirements:

- Anyone doing excavating work within or along the town roads or right of way must have a permit.
- All road cuts and shoulder work, including utility work must obtain a permit.

### Right of Way Access Permits Required:

- All new or repaved/reestablished Driveway accesses to town roads need access permits. (No drainage water of any kind can drain on to town roadways at anytime. May need drainage culverts or swale to correct drainage. All driveway drainage culverts are the property of property owner and responsibility to maintain. Also no double driveways allowed in Snowmass Village.)

### Right of Way Obstruction Permits required:

- Any Construction material, trailers, parked vehicles, etc. requires a permit. (In general all construction sites will require an obstruction permit)
- No improvements, including landscaping, trees, rocks, signs, marker posts, fences, etc. are not allowed along town road right of ways or within 10' of edge of pavement at any time. The town is not liable for any damage to any obstructions within the town right of way.

All Applications for permits must be submitted to the Public Works Division 7 day's prior work and approved before any work can commence. The Public Works Director, Town Engineer or Road Supervisor must approve all work.
