

LEGAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Town of Snowmass Village, a Colorado home-rule municipality, is seeking Federal Transit Administration assistance for administration, operating and capital expenses for the calendar years 2012 and 2013 through the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) under the Non-Urbanized Area Formula Grant Program Section 5311.

The Administration and Operating grant request is for continued support of:

- 1- Village Shuttle service on Route 3 between the Mall and Snowmass Club.
- 2- Village Shuttle service on Route 8 between the Mall and Town Park.

The capital expenses assistance sought is for the purchase of the following capital expense items:

- 1- Model Year 2012 – Two Gillig brand, 29-foot, medium duty transit vehicle with 27 seated positions and two wheelchair spaces.
- 2- Model Year 2013 – Two Gillig brand, 29-foot medium duty transit vehicle with 27 seated positions and two wheel chair spaces.

The vehicles will be used to provide transportation services in the Town of Snowmass Village. The deadline for submitting this application for such assistance to CDOT is June 6, 2011.
