#### PUT ON YOUR SEAT BELTS

I will be on vacation starting July 23 (Emily's birthday... she is turning 15) and returning to the office refreshed and ready to go on August 7. While I am away, Travis Elliott will be the acting Town Manager.

#### GET THE SCOOP

The first "Get the Scoop with Town Council" (FREE ICE CREAM) event is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, August 16. This will be at the last Thursday night concert of the summer and will also be when take the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual community photo. We will be advertising letting community members know that Town Council members will be available to answer questions and just hear what is on their mind. Hopefully this will result in some good conversation and only a few ice cream headaches. Please let Travis know if you will be able to attend so we can plan accordingly.

#### TID BITS:

- Work on the pedestrian improvements at the Town Park Station will start next week. As with all construction projects, there will be some minor traffic interruptions. The work is expected to take about 60 days.
- Little Miss Little Miss Little Miss, can't be wrong; The Spin Doctors are headlining Saturday's Deaf Camp concert. ATCKWBT (except the Kinney kids who will be on vacation)
- Charles Cunniffe Architects are starting the design process for Coffey Place.
- We are currently taking delivery of about a million dollars' worth of new boilers for the upgraded snowmelt system on Carriage Way. The new boilers won't actually be operational for the 18/19 winter season (they will be installed in the spring of 2019) but we needed to take delivery of the boilers this year so installation can occur in the spring of next year.
- SGM is continuing forward with a proposed design for the roundabout at the Owl Creek / Brush Creek intersection.
- We are continuing to update our Village Shuttle Route Map design. With any luck, the new and improved maps will be ready for this winter ski season.
- Speaking of the ski season, we are starting to work with stakeholders to develop the Winter Parking Plan.

- Because of the dry conditions, the high fire danger, and the potential for sparks, we have stopped mowing ditches and road shoulders. Once it starts raining, we will resume the maintenance.
- This week, the Town received an official notice from District Ranger Karen Schroyer informing the Town that East Snowmass Creek Bridge has been placed on the Aspen-Sopris Ranger District's list of 2019 projects. Their trail crew will be available in 2019 to assist with the installation of a trail bridge. Currently the Town is working with our engineer on a bridge design that will be stamped and submitted to a White River National Forest Engineer for review and approval. This design review will need to happen before the project can be implemented. We expect all of this to be completed in time for construction next year. We are very happy we were able to come to an agreement with the Forest Service and develop this in a cooperative effort with them.
