AN EARLY VERSION OF THE INFO UPDATE

I will be at the Colorado Association of Ski Towns on Friday, so here is a short, early, poorly developed version of this week's Info Update

TID BITS

- We are still working with the new owners of the Mall regarding a location for the Ice Age Discovery for this winter. We are not sure if we will be able to stay in the same location or if we will be required to move. Although we don't know where we may be located, we do know that we will be without a paleontologist. Stephanie has accepted a position with the Museum of the West in Grand Junction/Fruita. Although we won't have her scientific expertise, we are confident that our guest services team will be able to continue to tell the story.
- Budgets, Budgets everywhere..... The Council will receive its first review of the proposed 2019 Budget on October 1 and will get to review it more thoroughly at a number of regular meetings. If the Council wants to set up an additional half day meeting (as you have done in the past), we need to set a time that will work for you all.
- We are continuing to work with East West on Building 6. Knowing that the interior white box likely won't be occupied this winter, East West is planning to put a temporary bar on the outdoor building deck. They are planning to go through the official administrative modification process for land use review.
- 8,000 of your closest muddy friends will be in the Village this weekend. Tough Mudder starts Saturday. Upper Brush Creek Road will be closed to regular traffic, with a detour around Carriage Way. Only buses will be allowed through.
- We have decided to repair the gym floor in the Recreation Center by sanding it down rather than completely replacing the entire floor. Work will begin after Labor Day. As a critical tangent to this project, we are continuing to evaluate how to improve the heating and cooling system so that it won't flood the gym when it malfunctions. We hope to have an engineering report completed soon that will guide us in making the decision on best to proceed.
- The POSTR Board will be meeting next on September 26, 2018 at 5:30. One of the topics the POSTR Board will be reviewing is the concept to connect the Mountain View trail to the Rim Trail. We are planning to invite the adjacent property owners (who expressed concern about the trail at a recent Council meeting) to this meeting to better understand their concerns and ideas. At this point, this trail connection is

something we will continue to work through with the POSTR Board and neighbors to make the project as successful as possible.

- This morning, the Snowmass Water & Sanitation District crew started repairing a water main break along Brush Creek Road in front of Snowmass Villas (aka Blue Roofs) The work is taking place west of Sinclair Road. Unless the hole gets really big, they anticipate only closing one lane, with estimated 5-10 minute delays.
