

The Columbian Mammoth Rack

Features:

- The Rack celebrates our paleontological Treasure and the most important find in decades located below Mt. Daly.
- Unlike other racks this rack gently supports expensive modern wheels without damaging the rim or scraping the frame.
- Solid State welding and powder coating means zero maintenance for decades vs assembled racks of loose parts.
- Easiest entry for children available for any rack currently manufactured. All corners will be softened for safe use by children.
- FOUR slots are proposed (cost permitting)- three are shown here for added value.
- Locking loop for each slot, works with cable or Krytonite™ locks.

Cost:

Each rack will cost approximately \$3,300 to design, manufacture and finish. Shipping is anticipated to cost between 0 and \$260 per rack. It is recommended that multiple racks be ordered and shipped together for better value to the town.

Materials, Design, Manufacturing, Delivery and install:

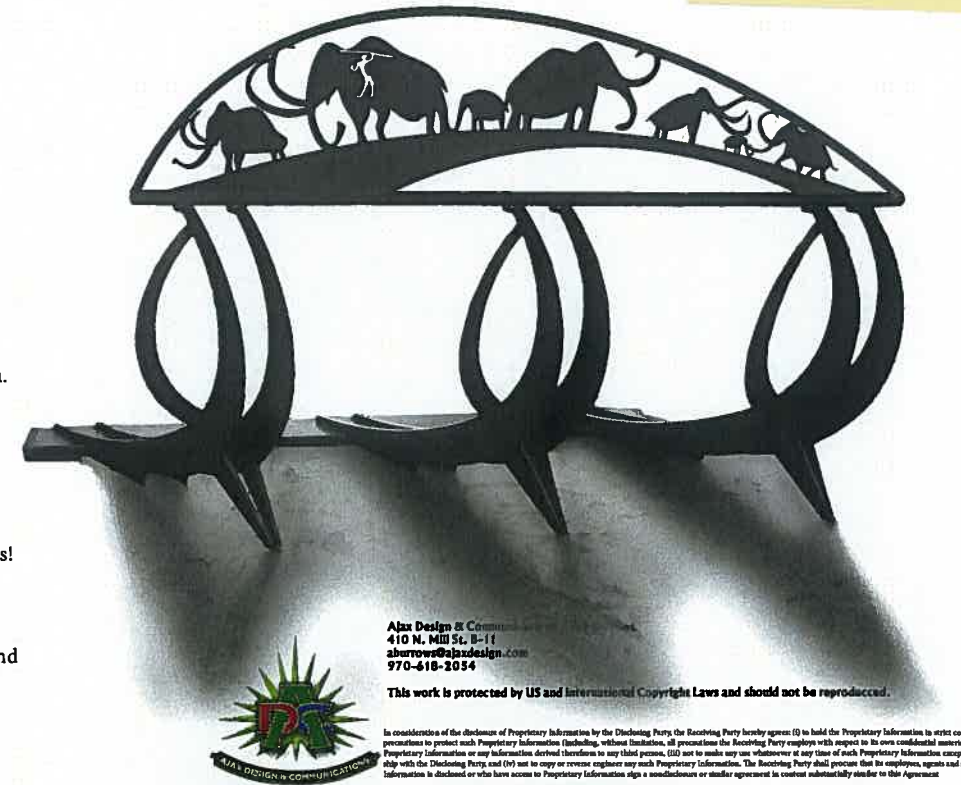
- Steel Plate Water Jet Cut & Welded. It makes the rack stable but light enough to be movable for seasonal use or snow removal.
- Will be finished in a variety of durable powder coated colors to be determined by TOSMV and the selection committee. (I recommend light colors for visibility.)
- Maintenance is minimal due to solid state materials, construction and finishing. **INSTALL:** Via two 8 inch bolts through base plate. This will require ramset sleeve into grade. These can be removed seasonally or for snow removal.
- Manufacturing will be done in Colorado and shipping will be done via pick up by TOSV vehicle (long bed pickup) so save pallet and trucking costs if possible. one person can handle each rack.

Note: this prototype has been manufactured and tested this summer to assure 100% function and ergonomics. Yes it is better than every other you will probably ever find. Just sayin. Remember function is KING and equal to aesthetics!
