Its BUDGET Time!!! Numbers and ideas are in the air... the process of deciding what we want to be and do as an organization is underway along with figuring out what can we afford?!?! The fun machine has started.

TID BITS

- The annual Get the Scoop event with the Town Council on Fanny Hill is set to be August 19. Free ice cream, music and conversation with community leaders is tough to beat.
- As part of emergency preparedness efforts, a new emergency generator will soon be installed at Public Works, helping to ensure these critical services can be delivered when needed.
- Our Ice Cube Sculpture artist has had his progress stalled as he waits for his polyurethane resin order to arrive. Like so many other products, Covid has affected the supply. He has tried a number of leads and other suppliers to no avail. The 4' sculptured cube was finished many months ago as was the rather complicated mold. But, unfortunately as of today, he still cannot give us an anticipated date for shipment. Ugh, I need a cold drink.
- Town Park Design is continuing forward. As part of the eventual implementation, we are exploring all sorts of funding opportunities including GOCO grants and Fishing is Fun grants.
- Speaking of Fun, our youth programs at the Recreation Center are super busy. So far this year, we have had 1,870 total uses by 387 unique kids. 117 of those unique kids are from the Village
- The County is advertising for community members to serve on the new Airport Advisory Committee. I think the town would be well served to have TOSV represented on that Board. The Town Council may want to consider how best to get representation on this committee.
- We are working with the Rodeo to develop a lease extension for their use of the rodeo grounds. The current lease expires at the end of this season.
- We are hoping to have the Winter Parking Plan adopted on August 16 so we can start selling parking permits in September.
- We are aiming to have the Little Red consultant under contract in early September.
