**AN ORDINANCE IDENTIFYING MANDATORY LEASH ZONES PURSUANT TO  
AMENDED MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 7-124 RELATED TO THE TOWN'S LEASH  
LAWS FOR DOGS**

**This Ordinance acts as a “companion” ordinance to Ordinance No. 7 and sets forth several proposed mandatory leash zones, which are identified on maps attached to the Ordinance. “Mandatory leash zones” would require a Dog to be kept on a leash, cord or chain no longer than ten (10) feet in length and of sufficient strength to effectively restrain the Dog.**

FIRST READING OF THIS ORDINANCE WAS APPROVED AT THE REGULAR MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 18, 2023 WITH A MOTION BY COUNCILMEMBER MAROLT, SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER SHENK, AND UPON A VOTE OF 5 IN FAVOR AND 0 OPPOSED.

SECOND READING OF THIS ORDINANCE WAS APPROVED AT THE REGULAR MEETING ON OCTOBER 2, 2023 WITH A MOTION BY COUNCILMEMBER SKENK, SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER GUSTAFSON, AND UPON A ROLL CALL VOTE OF 5 IN FAVOR AND 0 OPPOSED.
